LCM Exams - 2024 Dates (Asia)

LCM's graded examinations in most subjects are accredited by Ofqual (formerly the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority, QCA). The resulting mapping of LCM Examinations onto the QCF (Qualifications and Credit Framework) means that candidates applying to UK universities through the UCAS system can increase their points tariff if they have been awarded a Pass or higher at Grades 6-8 in an accredited subject.

Procedure to apply for a Grade/Diploma Examination.

- Kindly submit the duly completed entry form together with the fees / cheque / bank slip before the closing date. Please do not post your entries as there is delay in the post always. Kindly scan & email or courier.
- All <u>pre-requisites for candidates must be submitted with the entry form</u>, which could be obtained from the IIMSD office. For special approvals pre-requisites, programmes or any other requirement please contact the IIMSD office at least 2 weeks in advance before the closing date.
- Candidates without relevant pre-requisites for diploma entries will not be accepted at point of submission, and may be subjected to late entry fee/double fee in case the approval is obtained after closing date.
- Re-entry/Hall Fee entries Candidates applying for half fee permit due to medical reason should submit the following documents upon entry submission. Medical Certificate & Attendance notice.
- All Essays/Video files for Teaching Diploma in SPEECH & MUSIC must be submitted via email at the time of submission of entry for the Exam.
 Speech Diplomas The essay must be submitted at the time of submission of entry for the exam via an upload to the website: Icme.uwl.ac.uk/upload-work in both PDF and Word version. (Printed copy is no longer required via courier) Hard copy should be handed over to the examiner at the centre.
 Music Diplomas For candidates who are submitting essays for Music Teaching Diploma, has to be upon the submission of your centre's entries via an upload to the website: Icme.uwl.ac.uk/upload-work in both PDF and Word version. (Printed copy is no longer required via courier) Hard copy should be handed over to the examiner at the centre. An attendance notice is not required to submit essays.
